They've been locked away all those years, until now. They were outdated overstock when the company provided them for our **Ken Brown Engraving Workshops** that began in the spring of 2001. We've used hundreds in our classes and provided hundreds more to our students who completed our 3.5 day session near our Texas Studio; the compacts are part of our Ken Brown Certification process for students who opt to take that higher level of training to enhance their engraving abilities.




This freshly-opened tray, of this one design, was from a carton that came to us in 2001. We still have some left of the five different styles shown above, and are making an assortment of 25...five of each style...available to people who would love to give one to someone special....primarily thinking of MOTHERS DAY, May 10.

If you want one for a birthday or a family member, that's your choice....but *the intent* is that each of the 25 would go to a person nominated to get one.

Here are some sample ideas...




Your message might be this...to a worker, a graduate, or someone accomplishing a lofty goal.



The black lettering, done with a pen, is merely to show a sample of what YOUR words might be; they would be engraved to match the look of your message.



For someone not expecting a special birthday gift....



Perhaps you know a senior lady who would be surprised to receive a special gift on Mother's Day.



A simple *Thank You* for a good deed, a favor, or for just expressing your ongoing appreciation.



Each compact is signed and dated on the inside rim. The recessed area in each compact is for a translucent pressed powder insert and powder puff. These compacts have none; the refill inserts are available at any Estee Lauder counter in department stores, Sephora, and Ulta.



Each compact will be in a durable drawstring bag, with the recipient's name hand-written on the front.

Each compact has a mirror inside. A max of **two words** may be engraved there. Here are several possibilities.



HOW IT WORKS

- Nominate ONE person to get a compact. *It should NOT be for yourself.* Write a **short paragraph** why the lady you're nominating should get your surprise gift.
- **YOUR NOMINATION:** Email to [*ken@kenbrown.com*](mailto:ken@kenbrown.com) **SUBJECT: COMPACT**
 - *Your short paragraph telling why the lady should get a compact*
 - *Your name and connection to the person*
 - *Your phone number*
- **Deadline for your email to be received and your nominee to be considered is midnight, April 28.**
- If your nomination is accepted, we'll call you on April 29 to let you know and to get the name and mailing address of your nominee. A card will be enclosed in the package, saying the compact is from you.
- If your nomination is accepted, your engraved messages, on the compact we choose, must be a **MAXIMUM OF 8 WORDS ENGRAVED. TWO words max on the mirror, and SIX words max on the back.** Be thinking about what you'd want engraved so you're ready if we call to say your nomination was accepted.
- Again, for this, it will be our choice of compact design for your message.
- **THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR ANYTHING.** We provide compact, engraving, drawstring bag, packing, and shipping directly to the recipient, via U.S. Postal mail.

NOTE: A relatively few people on our facebook and Instagram page will see this and probably only a few will respond. Likely it won't be shared, so you won't be competing with a zillion people! We look forward to seeing your email.
